

How long is IELTS Speaking Part 2?

3-4 minutes









What do you need to do in IELTS Speaking Part 2?

You will have to **continuously talk for 2 minutes without a break**.

You will get a cue card from your examiner, a piece of paper and a pencil. He/she will read part of the cue card for you and give it to you. From that moment you will have 1 minute to prepare yourself for the 2 minute talk.







Example cue card

Describe an unforgettable advertisement (that you saw or heard).

You should say:

- What kind of advertisement it was
- What the content of the advertisement was (or what product or service was advertised)
- Where you saw or heard it

and explain why you think this is an unforgettable advertisement.







What are the 4 criteria the examiners look at to grade your speaking?

- 1. Fluency and Coherence
- 2. Lexical Resource
- 3. Grammatical Range and Accuracy
- 4. Pronunciation

What's do you have to do get a good score?









Tips

- 1. Don't memorise answers = 0 on your score
- 2. You don't need to talk about all 4 points but it helps
- 3. You need to talk for 2 minutes, talking less will reduce your score.
- 4. Use your time well to prepare
- 5. Use personal experience, otherwise LIE
- 6. Expand your ideas: Who, Where, When, Why, What, ...





Preparing your answer

You have 1 minute to prepare for the 2 minute speaking.

Most students waste this 1 minute and don't use it effectively.







Preparing your answer 2

On the card there are always 4 parts you need to answer.

Describe an unforgettable advertisement (that you saw or heard).

You should say:

- What kind of advertisement it was
- What the content of the advertisement was (or what product or service was advertised)
- Where you saw or heard it

and explain why you think this is an unforgettable advertisement.









Preparing your answer 3

Using the paper you can

- 1. Divide it in different parts
- 2. Create a mind map

You need to write down:

- 1. Some ideas
- 2. Some amazing language you want to use!

Practice 1

Describe a book that had a major influence on you.

You should say:

- what the name of the book is & who the author is
- how you first heard of the book
- what the main story of the book is

And explain why it played such an important role in your life.









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Practice 2

Describe a shop or store you often go to.

You should say:

- where it is
- what type of people go there for shopping
- what types of goods are sold there

and explain why you go there and like/dislike most about it.









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
Practice 3

Describe your favourite Restaurant.

You should say:

- what it looks like inside and outside
- what kinds of foods they serve

and explain what makes this restaurant so special to you and others.


