



Structure your writing: Task Achievement

- 1. Introduction: paraphrase the Task and graph (±25-30 words)
 - a. Repeat part of the task and the title of the graph in different words
- 2. General overview (±25-30 words)
 - a. A **clear overview** of the **main trends**
 - b. **No data** = no numbers here apart from graph outline.
- 3. In depth analysis (±100 words)
 - a. The main trends in more detail with data (numbers) as evidence
 - b. No interpretation <u>only facts</u> not:
 - i. I think there was an increase in unemployment because of the global economic crisis and COVID.
 - ii. Women socialize more because unlike men they enjoy talking with their girlfriends.
 - iii. There are more and more TVs in households, for example my family loves watching TV and we have 3 TVs ourselves.
- 4. Conclusion: NOpe!












