
## Task

# **Analysis**

**It is shown** in the diagram that how **the consumption of** some kinds of fast food changed from 1975 to 2000 among Australian teenagers, including pizza ,fish and chips and hamburgers.

At the beginning in 1975, fish and chips took the overwhelming amount , which was 100 times per year, while hamburgers' consumption was just around 10 times and pizza's even less at about 5.

However, things **shifted** dramaticly since then. The youngers ate more the less popular ones than fish and chips **which led to the sharp decline** of its used number until 1980, following by a little bounce and **then dropping again** straightly to reach the bottom of 40 below. Oppositly, the number of hamburgers and pizza were keeping soaring up hugely. At the point of 1985, **the increasing trend of** hamburgers minimized somehow and remained a constant slight rise till attending the highest figure of 100. Compared with that, pizza's cost had ten more years to grow until up to its biggest amount of 85, and **then became stable** till the end. In a nutshell ,hamburgers **were the most popular**, while fish and chips were not a hit any more.







# **Task Score**

### Task Response: Band 6

Aleksey, your response does a good job summarizing the main features of the graph and making relevant comparisons. However, there are some inaccuracies, and it lacks a clear overview. For example, your description of fish and chips consumption could be more precise. Also, the comparison between the three food items could use more detail.

#### Coherence and Cohesion Band 6

Your response is generally coherent, but the lack of clear paragraphing affects the logical progression of ideas. You try to sequence the information logically, but transitions between ideas could be smoother. Using cohesive devices inconsistently makes the reading experience a bit choppy. For instance, splitting the trends of hamburgers and pizza into separate paragraphs could help with clarity.

### Lexical Resource Band 5

Your vocabulary is adequate but somewhat limited. Most of the words are appropriate, but there are noticeable errors in word choice and collocation. For instance, "dramaticly" should be "dramatically," and "soaring up hugely" could be more precisely expressed. There's also some repetition of basic vocabulary, so a broader range of expressions would help.

## **Grammatical Range and Accuracy Band 5**

You use a mix of simple and complex sentence structures, but with limited flexibility and accuracy. Frequent grammatical errors, like "the youngers ate more the less popular ones," which should be "the younger people ate more of the less popular ones," detract from clarity. There are also errors in verb tense, subject-verb agreement, and punctuation that need attention.
